

- POSITION AVAILABLE:** Diagnostic Anatomic Pathologist. California Animal Health & Food Safety Laboratory System (CAHFS). The successful candidate will be in residence at the CAHFS laboratory on the UC Davis campus. This is a one-year contract position, with extension dependent upon funding.
- SALARY:** \$84,000
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Veterinarian with advanced training in anatomic pathology required. Board certification or eligibility by the American College of Veterinary Pathologists or equivalent required. Demonstrated interest, aptitude, and capability in livestock and avian diagnostic pathology, disease investigation and interest in herd/flock health highly desirable. Must possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills and a demonstrated ability to work with others in a collegial team atmosphere.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** Diagnostic Service: The candidate will function as a diagnostic pathologist with four board certified anatomic pathologists and one anatomic pathology resident. Duties include conducting and supervising comprehensive and timely pathological examinations on animals and tissues received. The candidate will route specimens to other laboratory disciplines; e.g, bacteriology, immunology, toxicology, etc., for ancillary testing and must be able to correlate findings promptly into written case reports for clients. The diagnostic caseload includes a variety of livestock and avian species with an emphasis of disease conditions affecting food animal species. Interaction with veterinarians, residents, livestock producers and, when appropriate, animal disease regulatory officials is an integral part of this position.
